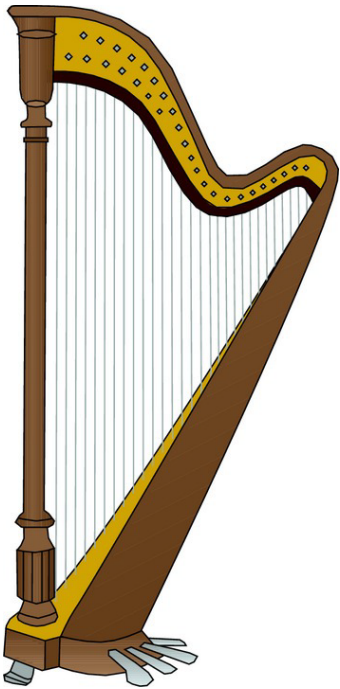
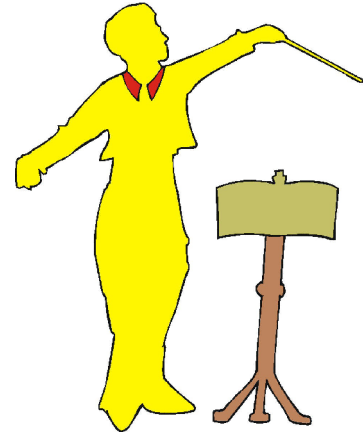

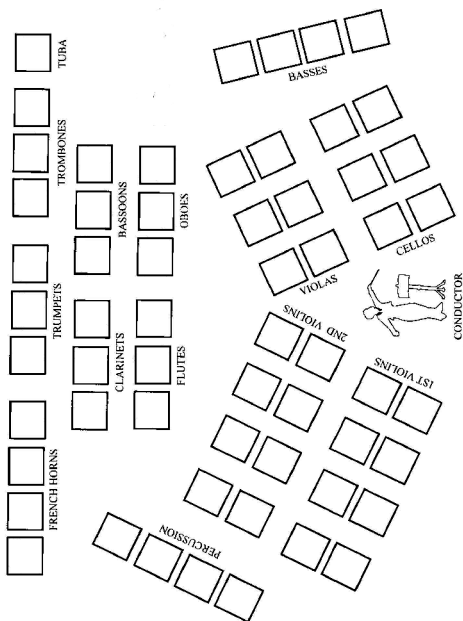

1) Fill in the blanks for each instrument.

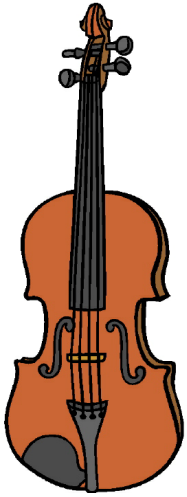
The instruments are spelled: violin, viola, cello, double bass, and harp.

2) Cut out along the solid lines and staple the pages together. Don't forget to put the cover on the front.

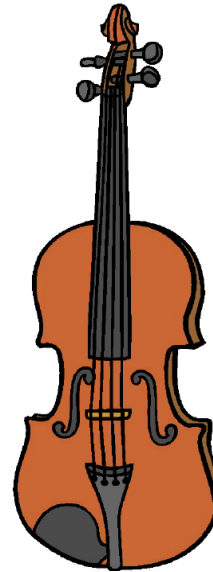
